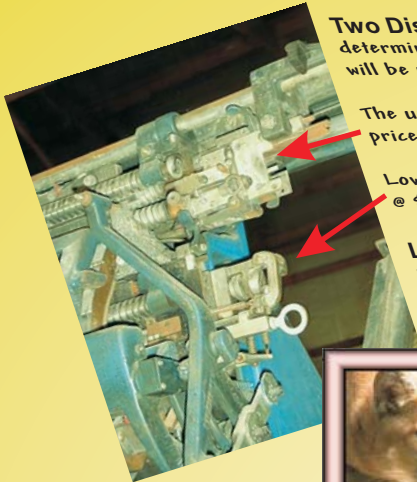


LINOTYPE UNIVERSITY IV — DENMARK, IA SEP. 24TH — 30TH 2006

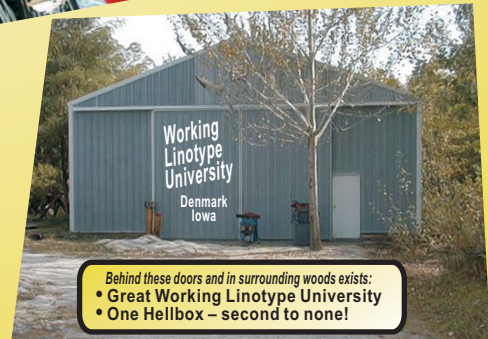
